

Learning objectives and possible Field II Learning Projects

Learning objective	Possible Field II assignment/Learning Product
2. Practice within the values and ethics of the social work profession and with an understanding of, and respect for, the positive value of diversity with an emphasis on American Indian families and communities.	Written documentation of a practice situation where the NASW Code of Ethics is applied using a specific screening tool, as found in the literature. OR Special seminar assignment.
5. Apply the knowledge and skills of an advanced generalist social work perspective to practice that is organized around micro, mezzo and macro system levels.	Written documents specific to particular field placement. Examples: Board resolutions, bylaws, mission statements, press releases, brochures, grants, program evaluations, needs assessments, case plans. OR Special seminar assignment.
9. Evaluate relevant research studies and apply findings to practice, and demonstrate skills in quantitative and qualitative research design, data analysis, and knowledge dissemination.	Research Proposal (SW 8102) and data collection and analysis done as a part of Learning Area #7 on Evaluation.
12. Use supervision and consultation appropriate to advanced generalist practice.	1-2 page description of the structure and dynamics of your supervisory relationship with your MSW Supervisor.
13. Function within the structure of organizations and service delivery systems, and seek necessary organizational and delivery system change.	1-2 page description of activities you completed during your field placement to assess and/or intervene around potential organizational issues (involving either your placement agency or another community organization).

Note that Learning Objectives 12 & 13 *must* be met through Field II since there are no other courses in the curriculum that address them.
